### RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS

I am duly aware of the risks and hazards that may arise through participation in the Community Garden and assume any expenses and liabilities I incur in the event of an accident, illness or other incapacity. If I have any questions about the Community Garden, its nature, the risks or hazards involved, I will contact the Community Garden Administrative Chair or the Service Director to discuss my questions to my satisfaction.

In consideration of being granted the opportunity to participate in the Community Garden for this year, I, for myself, my executors, administrators, agents, successors and assigns do hereby release and forever discharge Orange Village and its officers, officials (elected or appointed), directors, employees, and Departments, including the Service Department, Coordinator and volunteers who have signed a similar Release of All Claims and the cooperating landowner from any and all rights, claims of damages, demands, and any causes of actions whatsoever, including those based on negligence, in any manner arising out of my participation in Community Garden activities. I understand this release of All Claims means that, among other things, I am giving up my right to sue or to otherwise make any claims for any such losses, damages, injury or costs that I may incur.
3. I represent and certify that my true age is 18 years or older. I expressly agree that this Release of All Claims contains the entire agreement between the parties and the terms of this release are contractual and nor a mere recital.

## WOODMERE VILLAGE COMMUNITY GARDEN RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Community Garden, consistent with the Codified Ordinances of Woodmere Village, is under the control of the Service Director. The Service Director is authorized to enforce the Rules and Regulations governing the use of the Community Garden, subject to approval by the Mayor. Issues that arise should be taken to the Administrator who will then consult with the Service Director. A Community Garden Registration form, signature of acceptance of the Rules and Regulations, full payment of required fees and execution of a Release of All Claims form must all be completed by a gardener ***prior*** to that gardener doing any work in the Garden.

### Gardeners Expectations

- All gardeners are expected to begin planting by June 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Each gardener is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their garden plot. Watering, weeding, harvesting and any other garden related maintenance are all the responsibility of the gardener. Gardeners may arrange for other gardeners to water their plots.
- Walking paths are not to be blocked or damaged.
- Weeds shall not be left in pathways.
- Dispose of garden waste in designated areas only.
- Children are welcome in the garden but must be accompanied by an adult and must be supervised at all times.
- Return all shared tools to their assigned area.
- The application of herbicides (weed killers) to the garden plots is prohibited.
- Each gardener will be given a code to enter. Lock garden gate upon leaving.
- If you incur a hardship and cannot maintain your plot due to injury or illness, please assign someone and notify the Coordinator or Service Director.
- Gardeners may harvest vegetables and flowers from their garden only.
