## **Branches and Brush pickup**

The Service Dept. went through the village twice in April and also has gone through the village once already in May.

## **Litter**

Court Community Service performed litter collection throughout the village once in April and the Service Department has been picking up litter and debris as needed.

## **Service Department**

Keeping up with all necessary vehicle maintenance including buildings and grounds maintenance. (Village Hall and Brainard House).

## **Garbage and Recyclables**

Garbage and recyclables are picked up Monday's and Friday's (Including large items such as furniture, appliances etc.).

## **Storm Water Flood Prevention**

Periodic inspection and maintenance of catch basins, creeks and headwalls.

## **Other Programs**

Tables and chairs are available to residents. (delivery and pickup). Delivery of materials (mulch, topsoil, sand, gravel and stone). Dumpster drop off. All free of charge to residents.

## **Garbage Bags**

Garbage bags are in. Due to Covid-19 we will be delivering them to the residents. Residents need to call the Service Dept. and we will deliver the bags to them.

## **Leaf Pickup**

Leaf pickup is completed for 2020. If residents have more leaves they can bag them and put them out on Monday or Friday for pickup with their garbage.

## **Beautification**

Baskets have been delivered to Urban Growers for growing and should be delivered in late May.

## **Coronavirus**

All necessary steps are being taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

## **H.V.A.C. Project**

Mason Mech. has started our H.V.A.C project. The project is moving along very nicely, 2 rooftop units have been installed and are operating also the 4 split units have been retrofitted with Bipolar Ionization technology and are operating also. The duct work should be completed this week.

## **Community Garden**

The fence for the Community Garden will be installed on May 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> and the lumber for the raised boxes has been purchased and staged at the Curry House. Building of the boxes will start after the fence is installed.
