WHEREAS, Carolyn was born through a devoted union of Sarah and Chester DuBose and has three loving siblings, Michael, Linda, and Dawn; and

WHEREAS, Carolyn grew up in the Village of Woodmere and spent memorable years living on Roselawn Avenue, graduating from Orange High School in 1962, and earning an undergraduate degree in Elementary Education in 1965 from Ohio University in Athens, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Ms. DuBose was employed by the Cleveland Public School System and also served as a dedicated educator, and director of daycare centers in Cleveland and Oakland, California, teaching in the Cuyahoga County judicial system, the adult education division, and as a primary-grade educator in Botswana, Africa; and

WHEREAS, Ms. DuBose was civic-minded and cared deeply about the Village of Woodmere by serving two terms as a council member, once during Mayor Sherlie Hereford-Rainey's administration (1985-89) and then again while Robert C. Rice served as mayor for the Village (1990-1993); and

WHEREAS, in 2015, Carolyn moved to Atlanta to be with her sister Linda and enjoyed creating arts and crafts including painting, drawing, interior design, sculpting, making and then selling cloth dolls; and

WHEREAS, Carolyn is survived by her brother Michael DuBose; sisters Linda DuBose Alexander (husband Lanny) Dawn DuBose; son Kobi Michael-Lawrence DuBose and granddaughter Morgan Leigh DuBose; cousins Hollie Martin, Vivian Martin Sturgis, Eloise Martin East, Benet McMillan, and Elizabeth McMillan Baillergeau; and nieces and nephews Michael, Kelly, Kyanna, Brian, Darryl, Sholah and Kai.
