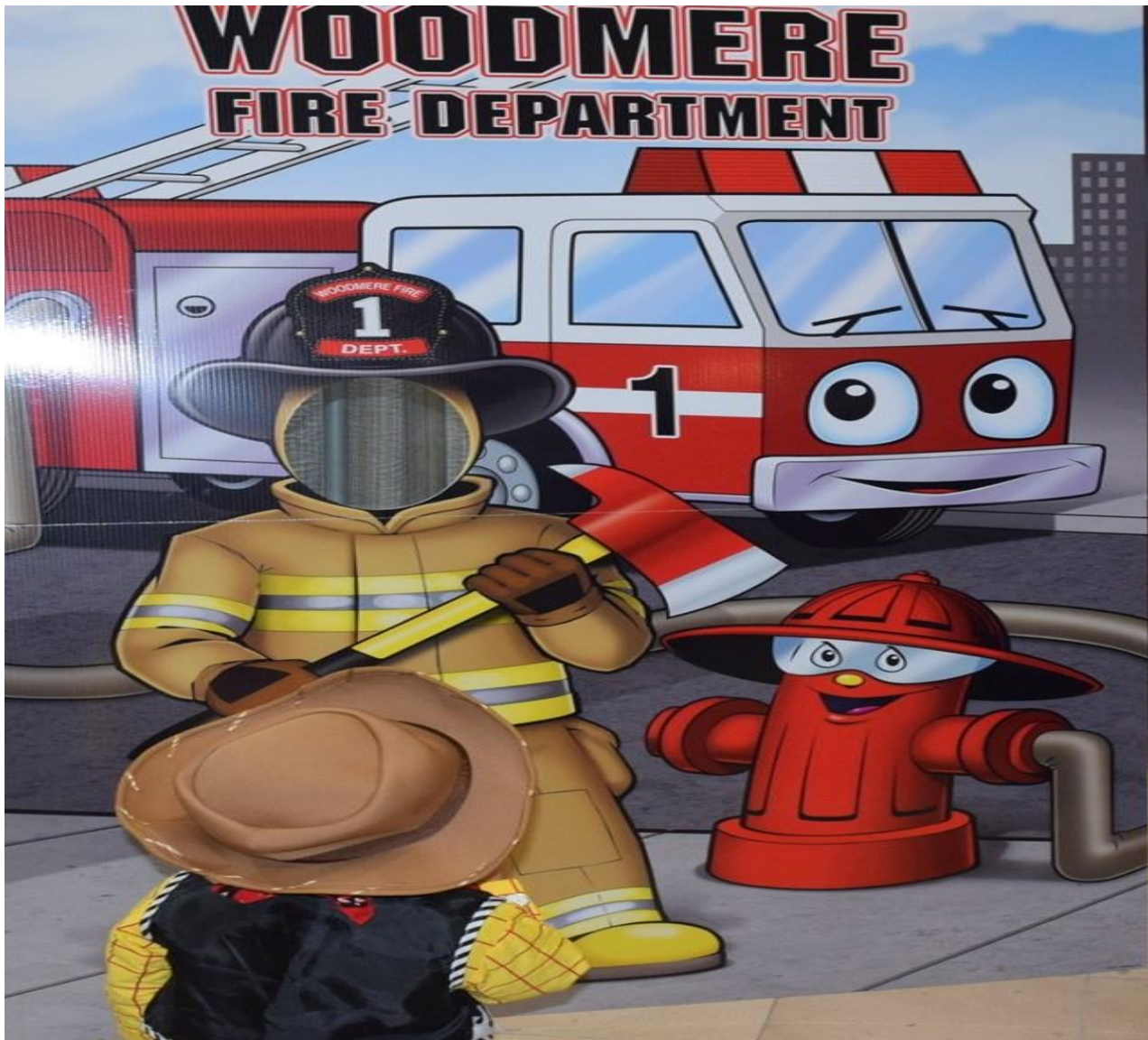
Station: Exhaust system unit damage, Engine 1 (Generator Exterior Switch, Ladder Rack, Pressure Relief Valve are Out of Service; Warning Lights and Jump line Switch are malfunctioning and air pressure leak), SCBA Cylinders (End of life-15years), Suction Unit Battery (End of Life – Likepak-12 Batteries and Cascade System (Out of Service), Tires for Squad 1, portable/apparatus radios nearing end of life/software mandate, and two Walkie Talkies are in for repair work).

Staffing: Scheduling Impact of COVID-19: 4 Home Quarantines, 7 Positive COVID-19 EMS Transports, 3 Members Tested COVID-19 Negative, and 8 Members Tested COVID-19 Positive.

Training: EMS: Adult ICU Care of Pediatric COVID Patients, Alternative Transportation, COVID-19 Global Conversations, EMS/Critical Care/ER: Taking Care of Ourselves, OB Emergencies, VAN Assessment
