

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-06

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR BENJAMIN I. HOLBERT, III

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT NO. 1 DATED JANUARY 11, 2022 TO THE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council adopted 2023 temporary appropriations pursuant to Ordinance No. 2022-105, setting forth certain appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the Treasurer has recommended to Council that a first amendment to the temporary appropriation ordinance, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, Amendment No. 1, dated January 11, 2023, which is incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, is necessary to account for certain changes in expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodmere, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The 2023 temporary appropriations of the Village, established by Ordinance No. 2022-105, shall be amended a first time by Council, as recommended by the Treasurer for certain expenditures, in accordance with Exhibit A, Amendment No. 1, dated January 11, 2023, which is incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, and such amended temporary budget is hereby adopted.

Section 2. To provide for operating expenditures during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2023, the amended appropriations, as recommended by the Treasurer in Exhibit A, Amendment No. 1, dated January 11, 2023, are hereby made and the Treasurer is authorized to prepare and submit the amended appropriations set forth in Exhibit A, Amendment No. 1, dated January 11, 2023, to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the Village's Charter and Codified Ordinances and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that it is necessary to timely submit the amended appropriations. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.
